MILITARY TRAINING

Specialist military deployment training includes parachute training, fast boat insertions and specialist

driving skills. Special Forces courses offer skills in Close Quarter Battle, Vertical Assault and Close Protection in a hostile environment.

We also offer a full range of battlefield and logistic courses including advanced first aid, search and rescue, and survival training.

Driver training covers use of a wide range of specialist military vehicles. These may vary from all-terrain vehicles to motorbikes, trucks, and staff cars. All require a different type of driving technique, with these techniques changing while driving over different terrains.

This course is designed to train drivers of military and civil vehicles in all aspects of driving on a day-to-day basis. This includes cross -country at night and staff car evasive driving.

PARACHUTE TRAINING



BASIC PARACHUTING

Parachuting offers the ability to land troops and equipment in an area of a commander's choosing, often in areas where land access for vehicles and ground troops is very limited.

This ability allows commanders greater flexibility in the planning process. Teams are able to be fully selfsufficient for many weeks during conflict situations.

FREE-FALL PARACHUTING

Free-fall parachuting is considered to be one of the most demanding parachuting skills. It can be used to infiltrate specific areas under the cover of darkness with varying weather and terrain conditions to avoid detection. Specialist troops are expected to land close to their objective as a combat ready tactical unit.

A final exercise will confirm that troops can form and understand Standard Operational Procedures and specific troop drills.

HELICOPTER SURVEILLANCE TRAINING

This will train military personnel in Helicopter Surveillance Specialist Techniques. The modern day battlefield is everevolving and changing, the pace of operations never slowing to allow the enemy the upper hand. Due to the vast area of operations, intelligence is vital to assure lines are not breached and information about the enemy is constantly updated.

Surveillance gathering can take on many forms, from foot patrols to observation post, mobile patrols and boat reconnaissance. Intelligence gathering with the use of helicopters allows greater distances to be covered at speed. The ability to remain undetected by the enemy comes with experience and practice by the pilot. The course is aimed at highly-trained senior pilots.

HELICOPTER CREWMEN

The helicopter is one of the most efficient and resourceful pieces of hardware available to the military. Its ability to fly in almost any weather condition makes it an essential aid in any mission. Aircrew have many roles to perform in the rear of the helicopter, acting as the eyes and ears of the pilot during landing, hovering and take-off phases. From cargo to personnel the crewman is responsible for their safety.

The training will be conducted by instructors who have countless hours of flying experience in locations all over the world. This will train military personnel to be helicopter crewmen in all flying Standard Operational Procedures.

The course will last for 6 weeks and requires the integration of trained pilots and their aircraft. Course numbers will be limited to 4 students per aircraft and Instructor.




AIRCREW WEAPONS TRAINING

This is when a competent and efficient Door Gunner (DG) is essential to the security of the aircraft and crew. 

This training will help to ensure that captured troops will withhold or limit battlefield intelligence and return safely at the end of any given conflict or release through negotiation.



DESERT SURVIVAL

To survive in arid or desert areas you must fully understand and prepare for the environment you will face. You must determine your equipment needs, the tactics you will use and how the environment will affect you and your tactics.

Your survival and the survival of others with you, will depend upon your knowledge of the terrain, basic climatic elements, your ability to cope with these elements and your will to survive.

OFFSHORE PROTECTION

Techniques in training military personnel in relation to Offshore Protection. Personnel are trained to deal with all potential terrorist incidents wherever they may occur. A key area that has seen a rise in hostility is the Maritime Industry due to the lack of security on ships and oil platforms. Counter Terrorism (CT) training is vital to the military as it ensures that the government and private industries have a high level of protection and security for offshore assets.

The training will culminate with an exercise looking at all aspects of launching a maritime assault on a terrorist hostage take-over situation.

The training will last for 4 weeks and will be conducted on ships, oil platforms, and various dry training areas.

Gaining entry to buildings or strongholds to search for and neutralize enemy forces or to release hostages requires special skills, including explosive methods of entry.

This course teaches troops many different methods which can be used to break into buildings or a stronghold. The key to the success of the entry lies in the ability to operate as a team. The course will be combined with the Close Quarter Combat module as these two modules run hand-in-hand in many operations.

Duration of these courses can be tailored around the client's requirements and facilities. As with all similar courses, a reconnaissance of facilities and a study of client requirements are key to delivering and meeting client expectations.





CLOSE QUARTER BATTLE (CQB)

The world's Special Warfare Units are frequently put into scenarios where the conventional soldier would not be able to operate. Training for these scenarios is intensive, with the emphasis being on teamwork, speed, motivation and tactics. 
COMBAT MEDIC

COURSE INCLUDES:

Primarily a counter terrorist assault team member, the Combat Medic, usually a military-trained personnel, is responsible for providing first aid and frontline trauma care. The Combat Medic is also responsible for providing critical medical care up to the point the casualty can be evacuated.





EMERGENCY FIRST AID

This First Aid and Emergency Response course requires no previous medical experience. It covers the full spectrum of First Aid training, from dealing with minor emergencies at work or in the home to keeping injured people alive in combat situations.

COURSE INCLUDES:

- Primary Survey, Artificial Ventilation, Child and Infant CPR

Search Teams have become the front line resource for operational commanders within both civil and military theatres. This course teaches the systematic Defensive and Offensive search methods and techniques used by UK police and military security teams.

The duration of each course is 5 days, however combined courses can be shortened to avoid duplication of training.



DEFENSIVE SEARCH

The role of a Defensive Search Team is primarily to counter threats by searching for improvised explosive devises (IEDs) at all venues used for:

- Sporting or other major events
- Conferences
- VIP visits
- Security sensitive buildings or areas

Students will learn the techniques, procedures and the equipment needed to carry out Defensive search. They will also learn the skills of conducting a Search Threat Assessment to determine search requirements.

OFFENSIVE SEARCH

The role of the Offensive search team is to locate weapons and ordnance, and to obtain intelligence and evidence for subsequent prosecutions. This is achieved by conducting a thorough and methodical 'fingertip search' of buildings, vehicles, vessels or open areas. Searchers are organized into specialist teams in order to concentrate on a small area to ensure that nothing is overlooked.

Students are trained to recognize all the component parts of bomb making equipment, improvised explosive devices (IEDs), weapons, ammunition and potential hiding places. They are also given the training to use sophisticated technical equipment and the skill to determine where to use it.

Students will also be taught scientific and psychological search methods used to locate rural and urban hiding places or caches. This method was developed and used successfully by the Northern Ireland Search Wing of the British Army.



The goal of this Program is to provide trained search-and-rescue personnel and K-9's to the law enforcement agencies of the USA and International clients, assisting them in their efforts to locate the lost and missing. These resources are available to law enforcement night and day, 365 days a year.

The combined landmass for the first shift response is up to the first ½ mile surrounding the Point Last Seen (PLS). These teams are all managed under an 'Operational Leader' through our own communications base run by 1-3 radio operators. Our base is linked directly to search management and is under their

Our wilderness-certified dog teams are trained to find the subject whether they are alive or deceased. We also train students to locate subjects who may be under water, in debris or buried in snow.

HAZMAT: OPERATIONS



This course provides preparation for command of initial incident operations involving emergencies within both the public and private sector referenced in NFPA standards 1561, 1710, and 1720.

Topics include incident management, fire-ground tactics and strategies, incident safety, and command/control of emergency operations.

Upon completion, students should be able to describe the initial incident system as it relates to operations involving various emergencies in fire and non-fire situations.

This course covers command-level operations for multi-company/ agency operations involving fire and non-fire emergencies. Topics include advanced use of

the Incident Command System (ICS), advanced incident analysis, command-level fire operations, and control of both man-made and natural major disasters.

Upon completion, students should be able to describe proper and accepted systems for the mitigation of emergencies at the level of overall scene command.

FIRE DYNAMICS & COMBUSTION



This course covers the theories and fundamentals of how and why fires start and spread, and how they are safely controlled referenced in NFPA standard 1001.

Topics include components of fire, fire sources, fire behavior, and properties of combustible solids, classification of hazards, and the use of fire extinguishing agents.

Upon completion, students should be able to describe the properties of matter and dynamics of fire, identify fuel sources, and compare suppressants and extinguishment techniques.

FIRE APPARATUS ENGINEER

The Fire Apparatus Engineer course is designed for firefighters who are assigned to operate fire department apparatus in the normal course of their duties.

It is designed to develop a firefighter in the areas of principles of water and water systems, mechanical principles of pumps and pump controls, intake and discharge hydraulics, aerial apparatus considerations, apparatus spotting, fire stream development, pump maintenance, service testing, acceptance testing, and pump troubleshooting.

The FAE will be able to generate effective fire streams from hydrants, relay operations, and drafting from static sources. Hose situations will range from single line problems up through multipleline relay operations to give the students a solid understanding of fire ground hydraulics, as well as practical solutions to be able to apply these concepts to their department.



FIRE SERVICE SUPERVISION



This course covers supervisory skills and practices in the fire protection field.

Topics include the supervisor's job, supervision skills, the changing work environment, managing change, organizing for results, discipline and grievances, and safety.

Upon completion, students should be able to demonstrate an understanding of the roles and responsibilities of effective fire service supervision.

MANAGING FIRE SERVICES

This course provides an overview of fire department operative services.

Topics include finance, staffing, equipment, code enforcement, management information, specialized services, legal issues, planning, and other related topics.

Upon completion, students should be able to understand concepts and apply fire department management and operations principles.

CHEMICAL, BIOLOGICAL, RADIOLOGICAL & NUCLEAR TRAINING (CBRN)

CBRN contamination is a very real threat not only in warfare but also as a potential terrorist weapon, such as 'low tech' radioactive dispersal, known as a 'Dirty bomb', Chemical and biological agents or poisonous gas and nuclear material are all within the capabilities of most terrorist organizations and many so called, 'Rogue States'.
